



Homeless Prevention Council Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how the Homeless Prevention Council (HPC) collects, uses, and discloses personal information about our participants, potential participants, and visitors to our website at <https://www.hpccapecod.org/get-help>.

Collection of Personal Information

Information connected directly from you: We may collect personal information directly from you through our website, during initial contact or ongoing conversations, to determine eligibility, schedule phone or in-person intakes, and provide follow up support. Personal information we collect directly from you may include first and last name, address, email address, and phone number.

Information collected from your device: Our website may use technologies such as cookies, web beacons, pixels, and other similar technologies to automatically collect certain information from your device including, for example, your IP address, date and time of your visit, browser and operating system information, referring website address, and other information about how you interact with the website.

Social media features: Our website includes Social Media Features (such as the Facebook and Instagram buttons). Social Media Features are either hosted by a third party. The third parties that own these Social Media Features may collect your IP address and which page(s) you are visiting on our website and may set a cookie to enable the Feature or Website to function properly. Your interactions with these Social Media Features are governed by the privacy policy of the company providing it.

Information collected from our partners: We may collect personal information about you from our third-party partners and combine it with other information that we collect. Personal information we collect from our partners may include, for example, your first and last name, phone number, and geographic location.

Use of Personal Information

We may use information collected about you for any lawful purpose, including the following:

- To provide confidential and flexible support, including any relevant intake and scheduling request.
- To provide our website, local resources, and hours of operation to you.
- To send text or email messages about events or reminders to respond, unless you reply “STOP” to opt out.
- To comply with the law and to maintain the security of our website; or
- With your consent, or as otherwise disclosed at the time information is collected.

Disclosure of Personal Information

We may share the information we collect with other parties, including the following:

- With Alive5, a third-party service provider, to assist us with making the text line accessible to potential participants to contact Homeless Prevention Council.
- If necessary to comply with applicable laws and regulations, to respond to a subpoena, search warrant or other lawful request for information we receive, or to otherwise protect our rights or the rights of third parties, or to protect the safety or security of any person or entity.
- With your consent or as otherwise disclosed at the time of data collection or sharing.
- No mobile information will be shared with third parties/affiliates for marketing/promotional purposes. All other categories exclude text messaging originator opt-in data and consent; this information will not be shared with any third parties.
- OPT IN CONSENT: By submitting your phone number, you are authorizing HPC to send you text messages and notifications. Message/data rates apply. Reply STOP to unsubscribe to a message sent from us.

We may share information that has been de-identified or aggregated without limitation. However, no identifying information will be shared without prior consent from program participants to ensure confidentiality is maintained.

Our website may offer interactive features, such as the ability to request services. If you disclose information in one of these forums, this information can be viewed, collected, and used by only HPC program staff.

Text Communications

If you wish to stop receiving text messages from us at any time, reply STOP.

Your Rights and Choices

You have rights regarding the personal information we maintain about you. We also offer you choices about what personal information we collect from you, how we use that information, and how we communicate with you.

You have the right to:

- You may unsubscribe from our email newsletter or other communications by following the opt-out instructions contained in the email.
- Limit the sharing of your information with third parties.
- Obtain confirmation that we hold personal information about you.
- Request access to and receive information about the personal information we maintain about you.
- Receive copies of the personal information we maintain about you.
- Update and correct inaccuracies in your personal information.
- Have the processing of your personal information restricted or object to the processing of your personal information; and
- Have the information blocked or deleted, as appropriate.

In the event you request the processing of your information be restricted or deleted, it could impact our ability to provide services. However, potential program participants may be able to access services by calling the office directly at 508-255-9667 or emailing info@hpccapecod.org.

To exercise these rights, please contact us as set forth below. You may withdraw any consent you previously provided to us. We will apply your choices going forward.

Information Security

We are committed to ensuring the privacy of your personal information and have established safeguards to help protect such information. For example, to protect your privacy, HPC uses passwords to help verify authorized user identity before granting access anywhere your personal information is stored. Though we strive to ensure the security of your information on our systems, no security measures are perfect or impenetrable and data transmission over the internet cannot be guaranteed to be 100% secure.

Changes To Privacy Policy

From time to time, HPC may revise its Privacy Policy to address changing technology, security measures and website functionality. Please make sure to review this policy frequently.
